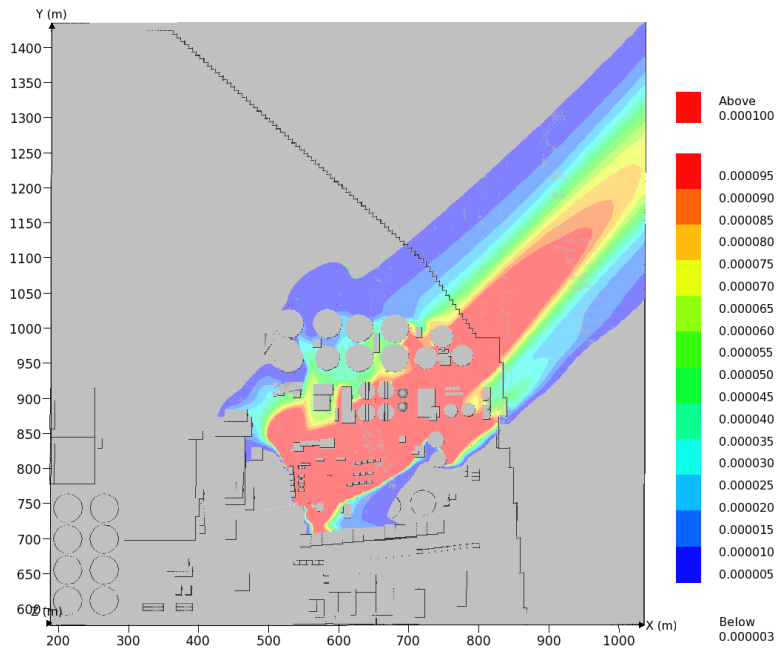

Ammonia Refrigeration Offsite Consequence Analysis

Preparing offsite consequence analysis for facilities covered by EPA Risk Management Program (RMP) rules and associated State programs such as California's Accidental Release Prevention (CalARP) program or New Jersey's Toxic Catastrophe Prevention Act (TCPA) requires careful analysis of site conditions to best describe source terms for Worst and Alternate Case releases and their community impacts. Kensington is practiced at working with plant staff in performing careful process hazard assessments and then using these results to create compliant offsite consequence analysis.
